Marco Turrina holds a degree cum laude in Business Administration from Milan's Bocconi University. From 1981 to 1985, he worked in Chase Manhattan Bank's Corporate Finance and Treasury departments in London and Milan. From 1985 to 1987, he was employed at Barclays International (BZW) in London and Milan where he oversaw mergers, acquisitions and Treasury operations. He was personally responsible for the introduction and development of derivatives products in Italy. In 1987, he was one of the founders of Akros Group, a company involved in a wide range of financial activities. In 1991, he was appointed managing director of Akros Attimo Sim and Akros Sim. In 1997, after obtaining the Bank of Italy's authorisation to transform Akros Attimo Sim into a bank, he was appointed chief executive officer and general manager. In 1998, when Banca Popolare di Milano took over Banca Akros SpA, he was confirmed as chief executive officer and general manager. In 2000, he also became Chairman of Akros Alternative Investments SGR SpA. He was appointed a board member of GSN North America Inc., a New York based stock broker. He is a member of the Investment Committee of the private equity firm Wise SGR and is vice chairman of the Steering Committee of Assosim. He is also a member of the Steering Committee of Banca Akros' parent company Gruppo BANCO BPM. He lectures at the Bocconi, Cattolica del Sacro Cuore, Luiss, Tor Vergata and Castellanza universities. He has also held seminars and workshops at the aforementioned universities. He speaks Italian and English.
